

Paediatric Stabilisation & Retrieval

A 2 day course to give candidates hands on experience in stabilisation and retrieval of the unwell child.

Candidates will take the role of NECTAR/transport medics in simulations and group discussions.

By the end of the course attendees will be able to:

- Clarify NECTAR framework and paediatric referral process.
- Apply NECTAR guidelines and protocols in the day-to-day work.
- Evaluate & stabilise critically ill children pre-transport.
- Recognise how to become involved in paediatric NECTAR transport for those who are interested.

The course is designed over two days, separated by 4-6weeks to give candidates the opportunity to reflect on what they have learnt,
